On behalf of the school community I would like to thank all the teachers for their commitment day in day out every school day in teaching all our children this term.

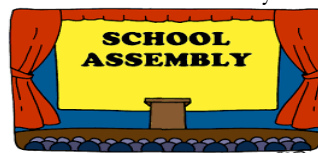
