








Punctuality is a golden rule.

Reading

Our focus will be on reading with fluency. *Fluency is the ability to read aloud consistently with natural rhythm and expression, recognizing or decoding words accurately while attention is focused on constructing meaning.* Aim to listen to your child read a page or a paragraph aloud to you twice or more in a week.

We are looking for volunteers to come and listen to a child read aloud to them. If you can give us 20 to 30 minutes on Wednesdays come see me.



Show and Tell

We are continuing from last term.

I highly recommend this activity to the children because it motivates them to look forward to school in the morning. "A happy start = a great learning day." ☺ The children develop their listening and communication skills through this fun activity. Your child will be encouraged to ask you to come as their show and tell if they haven't done so. You will talk for a few minutes about what you do and then let the children ask you questions.
